ELIGIBILITY

- **Child, Grandchild, or Ward of a PESO Lifetime Member.**
- The **Applicant** must be a graduating High School Senior (Class of 2024) accepted by a state accredited institution of learning in a curriculum leading to a Bachelor's degree in Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics (STEM).
 - Must have taken the ACT or SAT with a minimum composite score as follows:
 - **ACT – 24 SAT – 1160**
- Preference will be given to members of the National Honor Society.

AWARDS

- A non-renewable award of \$1,000, a plaque and complimentary dinner during the awarding ceremony on Saturday, November 23, 2024.
- A maximum of four (4) awards per year will be granted.
